STRUCTURE FIRE

(Oswego, IL) On October 28, 2015 at 9:15 PM, the Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched to the 500 block of Bent Tree Ct. for a reported chimney fire. Upon arrival, fire companies found a well-involved chimney fire on the exterior of the residence. Units made an aggressive attack, and deemed the fire under control within 10 minutes. There were no injuries reported. Units from Bristol–Kendall Fire Protection District and Montgomery and Countryside Fire Department provided coverage for Oswego during the incident. The fire does not appear suspicious.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
