The event begins Friday night, August 6th with the Lights & Sirens parade - kicking off on Rt 31 in North Aurora and winding its way past the North Aurora Days festival on Randall Road, through Aurora & downtown Montgomery, and completing the parade through downtown Oswego ending at Oswego Fire Station #1 with a private reception sponsored by Navistar International.

Oswego Fire invites you to downtown Oswego for the main event from 10 am to 4 pm on Saturday the 6th of August to see and visit with individual collectors, government agencies, and manufacturers of all sorts of emergency vehicles, as well as a variety of demonstrations put on by local police and fire agencies.

Participants may register on-line ahead of time, or beginning at 8 am on Saturday morning in front of the Oswego Public Library at 32 Jefferson Street.
