Oswego Fire Ambulance Part of Property Damage Only Vehicle Accident

(Oswego, IL) While enroute to a vehicle accident at US Rt. 30/34 & Hill Avenue in Montgomery, the responding Oswego ambulance was struck by another personal vehicle.

At approximately 0720 hours Oswego Medic-2 went enroute responding to a vehicle accident at US Rt. 30/34 and Hill Avenue within the village of Montgomery when their ambulance was struck by another vehicle. The ambulance and the other vehicle removed themselves to a nearby parking lot for accident reporting and injury assessment, thereby removing the ambulance from being able to continue on. It was determined to be a property damage only accident, no injuries reported with all involved parties signing Medical Releases, and the Oswego Police Department taking the accident report.

Additional ambulances were immediately dispatched to the original accident upon Oswego Medic-2 being taken out of service. Additional assistance to Rt 30/34 and Hill Avenue was provided by a Montgomery Fire Department ambulance and an Aurora Fire Department fire engine and ambulance.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
