Structure Fire *Surrey Road Boulder Hill*

(Oswego, IL) Around 19:30 hrs Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched for the possible structure fire. When crews arrived they found a fully involved attached garage with extension into the residence.

A coordinated offensive attack was made with the fire being contained to the garage and kitchen area of the residence. Smoke damage was noted throughout the residence.

No occupants were home at the time of the fire but one dog was located inside the residence and quickly removed by firefighters and is reported in good condition. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted by Montgomery, Bristol Kendall, Aurora Township, and Plainfield Fire Departments with assistance at the scene and station coverage during the incident.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
