Structure Fire 100 Block of Harbor Dr.

(Oswego, IL) At approximately 5:40 a.m., Kencom Public Safety Dispatch received a 911 call reporting a structure fire in the 100 block of Harbor Dr. Oswego Fire Protection District units were dispatched and arrived on the scene reporting a fire in the attic. Initial fire companies on the scene, initiated an aggressive interior attack and had the fire under control in approximately 15 minutes. The cause of the fire is under investigation, however, it does not appear to be suspicious in nature.

The four unit apartment building was deemed uninhabitable. The American Red Cross was contacted to assist the occupants with shelter.

One firefighter suffered minor injuries and was treated on the scene.

Bristol-Kendall Fire Protection District provided an Engine Company for mutual aid.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
