### Vehicle Accident *Battalion One Involved in MVA*

**(Oswego, IL)** On this date Battalion One with the OFPD was involved in motor vehicle accident.

Battalion One was responding for a Fire Alarm using lights and sirens. While responding eastbound on Rt 30 to the call, Battalion One was stopped and waiting for traffic in front of his vehicle to pull to the right so he could proceed to the Alarm. A collision occurred behind Battalion One causing a vehicle to be pushed into the rear of Battlion One. Montgomery Police were called to the scene. The Firefighter was not injured. The collision caused minor damage to the vehicle.

Both Oswego and Montgomery Fire responded on the call. A driver of another vehicle was transported with non life threatening injuries to Copley Hospital by Montgomery Fire and EMS.

Montgomery Police were investigating and report was obtained.
