Structure Fire *Schoger Road- Will County*

(Oswego, IL) Around approximately 22:00 hrs Ken-Com dispatched the Oswego Fire Protection District for a general alarm response for a reported structure fire.

Upon units arrival crews found a fully involved 30x15 shed type structure. Crews operated multiple hand lines to extinguish the fire which was contained to the building of origin. The building was unoccupied at the time of the fire and the building was a total loss.

No injuries were reported and the fire is under investigation by the Oswego Fire Protection District and the Will County Sheriffs Office. All units were cleared of the scene shortly after midnight.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted on the scene by Aurora Fire Department, Naperville Fire Department, and Plainfield Fire Protection District.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
