## Structure Fire West Side of Oswego

(Oswego, II) At approximately 7:10 PM, KENCOM Public Safety Dispatch Center received a 911 call reporting a structure fire in the 300 block of Bucktail Dr. Upon arrival, the initial fire companies encountered heavy fire in an attatched garage of a two story, single family residence.
