Structure Fire *200 Block Fox Chase Drive North, Oswego*

(Oswego, IL) At approximately 2206 hours on October 15, 2017 the Oswego Fire Protection District was called to the 200 block of Fox Chase Drive North for a structure fire. Upon arrival crews found the home to be well involved in fire. The general alarm assignment was immediately elevated to a box alarm.

The home was occupied at the time of the fire, and the occupants were outside the home upon arrival. There was a single injury reported by an occupant and the occupant was transported by OFPD EMS.

The fire was extinguished. Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District, Montgomery Countryside Fire Protection District, Aurora Township Fire Protection District, Aurora Fire Department, Sugar Grove Fire Protection District, Minooka Fire Protection District and Plainfield Fire Protection District assisted during the fire. Some units assisted at the scene and some covered the Oswego stations until the fire was extinguished.

Approximately \$400,000 dollars in damage was estimated. The fire is still under investigation at this time.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
