Structure Fire Stone Hill Rd. Oswego

(Oswego, IL) On October 20, 2017 at approximately 2:25 P.M. the Kendall Co. Communication Center dispatched a general alarm for Oswego F.P.D. to respond to Stonehill Rd. in Oswego for a possible structure fire in a business. Three engines, two ambulances, a ladder truck, a Battalion Chief and a staff Chief responded on the alarm. First arriving companies reported a working fire in a storage loft of an end unit in a multiple tenant business. The fire was extinguished, cause of the fire is under investigation. Initial damage is estimated in excess of \$100,000. No civilian or firefighter injuries were reported. Oswego was assisted by Bristol-Kendall F.P.D., Aurora Township F.P.D., and Montgomery Countryside F.P.D. providing coverage in Oswego's district.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
