Activated Fire Alarm With Small Fire in Buisness *Stonehill Industrial Park Oswego, IL*

(Oswego, IL) At 06:04 Oswego Fire Protection District received an activated fire alarm. While responding, dispatch advised that callers in the area were smelling smoke. With the additional information the alarm was upgraded to a General Alarm.

Upon first crews arrival firefighters found heavy smoke coming from an end unit of a multi unit industrial building with an activated sprinkler system. Firefighters were able to find a small fire located in a lumber storage area. Fire crews quickly extinguished the remaining fire.

No injuries were reported.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted with station coverage by Montgomery and Countryside and Bristol Kendall Fire Protection Districts.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
