Structure Fire *Churchill Club Subdivision*

(Oswego, IL) At Approximately 11:24 am the Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched to the 400 block of Bluegrass Parkway in Oswego for the reported structure fire.

Upon arrival units reported heavy fire in the basement with extension to the first floor and attic space.

An interior attack was made to extinguish the fire. One dog was rescued on the second floor and one occupant was injured while trying to extinguish the fire before exiting the residence. Estimated loss was around \$450,000. The cause of the fire was listed as improperly discarded smoking materials.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted by Montgomery Fire Department, Auarora Fire Department, Aurora Township Fire Departmet, and Plainfield Fire Departent.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
