Structure Fire 100 Block of Stonegate Dr.

(Oswego, IL) Oswego Fire Protection District Firefighters respond to a reported structure fire.

At approximately 7:58 pm, Kencom Emergency 911 Center received a report of a structure fire in the 100 block of Stonegate Dr., in Oswego. A General Alarm was dispatched, three Engines, two Ambulances, one Truck, and three Chief Officers responded to the scene. Initial units on the scene, reported a fire in a walk out type basement. A hose line was stretched, and an aggressive interior attack was initiated. The main floors of the residence were checked for fire extension. The fire was deemed under control within 20 minutes. Due to smoke damage on the main floors of the residence, the house has been deemed inhabital at this time. The cause of the fire does not appear to be suspicious in nature.

The residence was occupied at the time of the fire. All occupants were out of the building when the fire companies arrived. No injuries were reported.

The Plainfield Fire Protection District provided and Engine to fill in Oswego Station 1, during the incident.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
