The OFPD scholarships are given in honor of a member of our District that has shown exemplary service to the people of the community we serve. This year, former Fire Chief John Moyer is being honored. He dedicated his life to serving the people of our District in many capacities. He started his career in 1956 and served as a volunteer firefighter until 1988, then promoted to Fire Chief, which he served from 1988 to 1992. Chief Moyer exemplified what it means to be a firefighter. He truly dedicated his life to his community and the Fire District, until his death in April 2012. The OFPD would like to honor Retired Fire Chief John Moyer by awarding \$500.00 scholarships to two graduates that will be pursuing a degree in the fall of 2019.

Scholarship Guidelines

1. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a degree in Fire Science or a related field
2. Those applicants pursuing a career in Public Safety will also be given preference, but weighted less than those in the Fire Science field
3. Applicants must reside within the Oswego Fire Protection District boundaries and be graduating in the spring of 2019
4. Applicants must be attending an institution of higher learning in the fall semester of 2019
5. Applicants may receive the scholarship only once
6. Applications will be screened and scholarships awarded by the OFPD scholarship committee (The *OFPD* reserves the right to choose the students that best meet the criteria for the award)
7. Contingent upon availability of qualified applicants, the scholarship may not be awarded annually
8. Only applicants that include the one page essay and transcript shall be considered
9. Applications are due no later than April 30th, 2019 at 3:00 pm and must be returned to Oswego Fire Station #1 located at 3511 Woolley Rd. Oswego, IL, 60543. (*Care of Assistant Chief John Cornish*)
