### Water Rescue *Fox River in Oswego, Illinois*

(Oswego, IL)

At approximately 10:30 am this morning Oswego Fire Protection District members were dispatched for a General Alarm water rescue. The location given was on the Fox River, in the area of US Route 25 and Boulder Hill Pass. Upon fire district members arrival, a male subject was located in the water and was calling for help. One rescue swimmer was deployed and was able to bring the male subject to an island where they were picked up by a fire district boat. The male subject was treated and transported for non-life-threatening injuries by Oswego Medics.

One male patient was transported to Rush-Copley Medical Center for cold water related injuries.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted with station coverage by both Sugar Grove Fire Department and Naperville fire Department.

*The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.*
