### GREASE FIRE *McDonalds*

**(Oswego, IL)** At approximately 4:25 PM, Oswego Fire units were dispatched to the 300 block of Douglas Rd., for an activated fire alarm. Upon arrival of the initial fire company, they found smoke coming from the roof. At that time, they upgraded the alarm.

Upon further investigation, companies found a grease fire in the fryer. The fire activated the extinguishing system. However, the fire got hot enough to activate a sprinkler head in the attic, and it ignited some of the insulation around the exhaust pipe for the hood system. The building suffered extensive damage. The business will be closed for an unknown amount of time.

No injuries reported to any Firefighters, employees, or customers of the business.

Oswego Fire units were assisted on the scene by, the Village of Oswego Building and Zoning Department, Kendall County Health Department, COMED, and NICOR.
