Structure Fire Wolf Road Oswego

(Oswego, IL) At approximately 4:30 pm the Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched for a reported structure fire in the 1700 block of Wolf Road in Oswego. Upon arrival units found a two story wood frame barn fully involved. The fire had also spread to the harvested corn field adjacent to the barn. The fire was kept from spreading to the nearby residence and other structures on the property.

The barn and contents were a total loss and no injuries were reported. The fire was accidental in nature and caused by embers from a camp fire near the barn.

Aurora, Bristol-Kendall, Little Rock Fox, Plainfield and Minooka fire departments assisted at the scene. Naperville, Sugar Grove, and Troy fire departments provided station coverage during the incident.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
