AED Loaner Program *Oswego Fire Has a Heart for the Community*

(Oswego, IL) The Oswego Fire Protection District is excited to introduce a new AED Loaner program. An Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) can give a second chance to a person suffering cardiac arrest. AED's are portable, self-contained and require only basic instructions to use. However, to be effective, they must also be readily available.

The AED Loaner program allows identified businesses access to one of these loaner AEDs, which the Oswego Fire Protection District received free through participation in the Military Surplus Program.

Oswego Fire is identifying businesses and locations to place these AEDs, which will be loaned FREE to the business. We will provide in-service training to staff of the business on how to use and maintain the AED. However, the business will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and resupply of pads for the AED.
