### Ice Rescue Women Rescued After Falling Through the Ice

**(Oswego, IL)** At approximately 1000 hours the Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched to the area of Bridgeview Dr in Oswego for an ice rescue. Upon her dog wondering onto the ice, a woman followed it and each broke through the ice and fell into the water. Upon fire crews arrival, one victim had been rescued by Oswego Police and a nearby resident. The patient was treated by paramedics on the scene.

Rescue efforts were conducted, and crews were unable to locate the missing dog.

No firefighters were injured.

Bristol Kendall Fire and Sugar Grove Fire assisted during the incident.
