Oswego Fire Conducting Training On Acquired Structure

(Oswego, IL) The Oswego Fire Protection District will be conducting training on Rt. 34 between Fifth Street and Prairie Market Dr. The training will be ongoing for the next two weeks.

Already slated for demolition, the two-story house at that address was donated to the OFPD as an opportunity to conduct training. There will be theatrical smoke used, but no live fire training done at this time.

Conducting training in an acquired structure is an excellent opportunity for our firefighters to learn new ideas and hone existing skills.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
