Record Breaking Calls for Service

(Oswego, II) The Oswego Fire Protection District has reached 6,000 calls for service for the first time in Department history. At 0930 hours the O.F.P.D. ran their 6,000th call for service this year. This is 299 more calls for service than the whole year of 2020. O.F.P.D. is currently on pace to reach over 6,300 calls this year. This is a 57% increase in calls for service since 2011. This is mostly due to the increase in service population. The Oswego Fire Protection District provides emergency services to more than 70,000 residents. The district provides services to 53 square miles incorporating all of Oswego, portions of Plainfield, Montgomery, Yorkville, Bristol, and some unincorporated areas of Kendall and Will Counties including all of Boulder Hill.
