Structure Fire Williamsburg Ct.

(Montgomery, IL) At approximately 00:45, Ken-com 911 Center received reports of a house on fire in the 200 block of Williamsburg Court, Montgomery, IL. Ken-com immediately dispatched a general alarm response for the Oswego Fire Protection District.

While companies were enroute, Ken-Com advised there was two subjects trapped on the second floor. Station #2 companies arrived on scene within 5 minutes of initial dispatch to find a heavily involved center unit townhome. Both subjects had self-extricated themselves via a second-floor window. Both Montgomery PD and Kendall County Sheriff's Deputies assisted both fire victims to the awaiting ambulances. Fire crews initiated an aggressive interior attack and quickly extinguished the fire. No damage was noted to either adjoining units of the townhome. The fire is currently under investigation and currently does not appear to suspicious in nature. Estimated damages at this time are \$250,000.

No injuries were noted to any firefighters, however, both fire victims were transported to an area hospital.

During the incident, Oswego was assisted with station coverage by Plainfield Fire Protection District, Aurora Township Fire Protection District and Sugar Grove Fire Protection District. Plainfield Fire Protection District also provide a Battalion Chief to the scene to assist with on scene operations.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
