(Oswego, IL) On Saturday, June 4, 2022 the Oswego Fire Protection District will be hosting an Open House at Station One at 3511 Woolley Rd. in Oswego. This event is a great opportunity to meet Pumper the Fire Pup and to learn about fire prevention and fire safety. New this year, the Fire Chief will be hosting two informational talks sharing information about the fire district.

The day's activities will include a live fire demonstration, a safety trailer for the kids to go through, real fire gear for the kids to try on, a skill station to show everyone your "Stop, Drop, and Roll" skills, a "kid-sized" firefighter obstacle course, and the chance to meet real firefighters.

The most popular portion of the Open House every year is the raffle where we offer a chance for one lucky student of the fire district to win a ride to school in a fire engine.

There will be light refreshments and popcorn, and the Open House will run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
