Basement Fire 4000 Block of McLaren Drive

At approximately 1830, Ken-com 911 Center received reports of a basement fire in the 4000 block of McLaren Drive, Oswego, IL. Ken-Com immediately dispatched a general alarm response for the Oswego Fire Protection District. Upon arrival, fire crews promptly located and extinguished a basement fire within approximately four minutes. The fire was confined to the area of origin. No damage estimates are available currently, and the home remains habitable. The cause of fire remains under investigation and does not appear suspicious in nature.

One civilian on scene was treated and released for non-life-threatening injuries. No injuries were reported to emergency personnel.

Oswego FPD was assisted by Plainfield Fire and Montgomery Fire on the scene, and station coverage was provided by Aurora Township Fire.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
