Basement Fire Oswego

(Oswego, IL) At approximately 1:00 PM, KENCOM Public Safety Dispatch Center received a 911 call of a fire in a residence in the 300 block of Amston Ct. A General Alarm assignment was dispatched. Upon arrival, the initial fire companies found a working fire in the basement of the residence. An aggressive interior attack was initiated, and the fire was under control within 10 minutes.

The occupants of the residence were out of the building on the arrival of the initial fire companies. At this time, there is not a damage estimate available. The MABAS Division 15 Fire Investigations Team was activated to assist with the investigation.

No injuries reported to any Firefighters. There was an occupant that was transported to the hospital by Oswego Fire Department Ambulance.

Oswego was assisted by Plainfield, Bristol-Kendall, Sugar Grove, and Naperville Fire Departments. Village of Oswego Building and Zoning was also requested to the scene.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
