Structure Fire Springbrook Trail South

(Oswego, II) At approximately 0215, the Oswego Fire Department was dispatched for the reported structure fire in the 200 block of Springbrook Trail South. A general alarm was transmitted for the working fire inside the multi-tenant residential unit that was occupied.

Upon arrival, in approximately 4.5 minutes from dispatch, E2 arrived on scene to find a well involved garage fire attached to an occupied multi-unit residential tenant space. Within minutes of arrival the fire was extinguished, searches completed, and all occupants were assisted out of the building. Working smoke detectors contributed to early notification, and the occupants of the affected building to self-evacuate prior to arrival.

No injuries were reported to occupants or firefighters. The unit was deemed uninhabitable and sustained major damage to the garage area. No dollar loss is immediately available. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

Mutual aid to the scene was provided by Aurora Fire Department and Plainfield Fire Protection District. Station coverage was provided by Plainfield, Sugar Grove, and Montgomery Fire Protection Districts.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
