### **Building Fire Commercial Building**

**(Oswego, IL)** At roughly 7:40 PM., Oswego Fire Department personnel were dispatched to Brokaw Early Learning Center, 1000 Fifth St. for a commercial fire alarm. Upon arrival, initial fire companies found smoke in the building, and smoke coming from the roof. The alarm was upgraded, and additional fire companies were dispatched.

After further investigation, there was roofing material found burning on the roof. A hose line was stretched to the roof and the fire was quickly extinguished. No further extension found. The fire is currently being investigated by Oswego Fire Department investigators, along with the Oswego Police Department. No damage estimate is available.

The building was not occupied at the time of the incident. No injuries to any Firefighters.

Oswego Fire Department was assisted on the scene by Aurora Fire Department, Plainfield Fire Department, and Bristol-Kendall Fire Department.

*The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.*
