Fully Involved Attached Garage Fire 300 Block of Ogden Falls Blvd.

(Oswego, IL) Rapidly spreading garage fire that extended into the homes attic space aggressively attacked and knocked down!

Shortly after midnight, Ken-Com 911 Dispatch Center received numerous reports of a fully involved garage fire. Upon arrival of first due fire units, fire was in the rear attached garage of the home and had extended into the upper floors and attic space. An aggressive attack was made on the initial fire building and the fire was contained to the building of origin. Both adjacent homes sustained heat damage to their outside siding but no structural damage. The home was searched, and any remaining fire was extinguished. A partial collapse of the second floor above the garage as well as the garage itself occurred and no firefighters were injured. At this time the structure is determined to be uninhabitable by building and zoning. The cause of the fire remains under investigation and an estimated dollar loss was not available at time of print.

There were no reported civilians or firefighters injured during the incident and all pets were accounted for as well.

Oswego Fire Protection District was assisted on the scene by Plainfield Fire, Aurora Fire and Oswego PD. Station coverage was provided by Plainfield Fire, Montgomery Fire and Sugar Grove Fire.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
