Structure Fire 100 Block Seton Creek

(Oswego, II) The Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched to the 100 block of Seton Creek Drive for the report of a structure fire in a single-family residence.

KenCom dispatched a structure fire response at approximately 1759. The first arriving engine was on scene in approximately 4 minutes from dispatch and confirmed a working fire on the second floor of the residence. Crews were able to rapidly extinguish the fire, and the main body of the fire was extinguished within minutes of arrival. The cause of the fire is under investigation and does not appear to be suspicious in nature. No dollar loss estimate was immediately available.

All occupants were out of the home upon arrival. One civilian was treated on the scene for minor injuries and did not require transport to the hospital. No injuries were reported to firefighters.

The OFPD was assisted on scene by the Aurora Fire Department and Plainfield Fire Protection District. Additional station coverage and assistance for unrelated calls was provided by Montgomery and Sugar Grove Fire Protection Districts.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
