Structure Fire on Far East Side 10100 Block of S. Sunridge Dr. Naperville, IL

(Oswego, IL)

Shortly after 07:30, a General Alarm was dispatched for a possible fire in a vacant home. Ken-Com 911 Center received a report of a possible fire on a deck of a vacant home in unincorporated Will County, on the districts far East side. Firefighters arrived on scene to find a working fire in the lower level, of a two-story wood frame vacant home. Firefighters quickly forced entry and began to extinguish the fire while additional members searched for victims. The fire was brought under control within 15 minutes. The cause of the fire remains under investigation and does not appear suspicious in nature at this time.

No injuries to civilians or firefighters were noted at the time of the incident.

Oswego FPD was assisted by Plainfield Fire, Naperville Fire and Aurora Fire on the scene. Station coverage was provided by Montgomery Fire and North Aurora Fire.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
