These exercises will provide valuable hands-on experience in real-world settings, helping our firefighters to respond effectively to any situation that may arise. Please note, we will be using theatrical smoke during the training.

We understand that such activities can generate interest and curiosity among the community members, and we want to assure everyone that safety measures will be in place at all times. Residents and patrons can expect to see fire trucks and personnel at the training locations during the specified hours.
