Residential Structure Fire East Washington Street, Oswego

(Oswego, II) At approximately 3:27 A.M., the Oswego Fire Protection District was dispatched for a structure fire in the 0-100 block of East Washington Street. While apparatus was enroute, Kencom Dispatched advised that the caller believed the fire started on the outside of the house and was spreading inside. Initial arriving units found fire showing from the rear of 2-story home.

Crews stretched a hose line through the front door to extinguish the fire that had extended to the attic. A second line was deployed to the rear of the structure. A search was carried out and the home was cleared of any occupants. Overhaul was performed to ensure the fire had not spread and that it was completely extinguished. Crews are still on the scene as of the writing of this press release.

No injuries were reported. The home was deemed uninhabitable due to the damage sustained. No dollar loss estimate is immediately available. The cause of the fire appears to be accidental in nature.

Mutual aid to the scene was provided by the Plainfield Fire Protection District and Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District. Station coverage was provided by Bristol Kendall Fire Protection District and the Sugar Grove Fire Protection District.

The Oswego Fire Protection District was formed by voter referendum in March of 1936, covers over 60 square miles in the northeast portion of Kendall County and about 1.5 square miles of northwest unincorporated Will County.
